

TBS Paintwork (care instructions)

A paint finish on TBS doors is a durable and long-lasting type of coating. After a thorough pre-treatment, the primer and the final coating are applied.

Chalking is unavoidable as exposure to UV rays is always present. Regular application of a wax polish can slow down chalking. The type and amount of chalking also depends on:

- Age of the paintwork
- Colour tone (light tones chalk out less than dark ones)
- Cardinal direction (facing south and/or west, higher load)
- Stress (more on a busy road than on a road with little traffic)
- Environmental pollution
- Care

With our weathering class, a paint finish should retain good quality between 2-5 years. With regular care (washing with clear water or similar), a longer service life is also conceivable. **In case of incipient chalking, a treatment with a polish helps to prolong the fading here.**
